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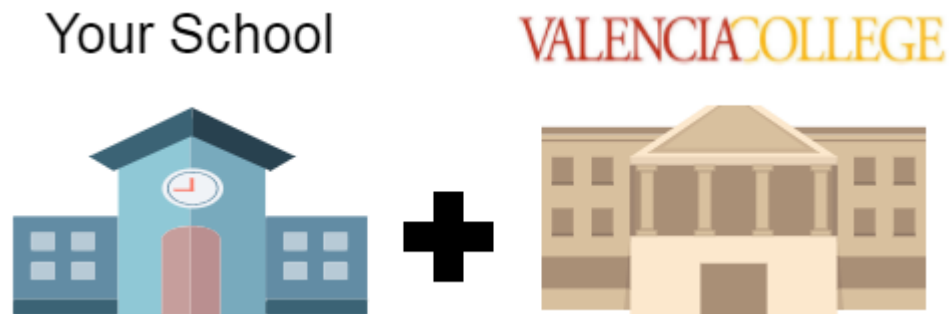

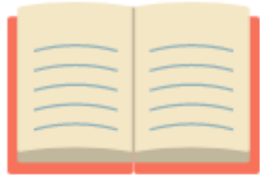

- ***Increased coursework is not allowed***

## Maintaining Eligibility

- Complete high school graduation requirements
- Continue communication with DE Academic Advisors
- Must maintain a **2.0 VC GPA and 3.0 HS GPA**
- 2 successive terms of less than 2.0 VC GPA results in ***Academic Probation*** and program dismissal
