**2-D Studio Art 1** (Overview of drawing, painting, and art history—project based)

**Agri-science** (4H and FFA learn about large animals and modern farming techniques)

**AP Computer Science Principles** (have passed Alg 1--will learn central ideas of computer science)

Academies

**Digital Video** (HD cameras, professional grade broadcasting studio, and editing software)

**Engineering** (overview of the engineer field/use of computers and hands on activities)

**Fashion** (learn design and sewing skills necessary to work in the fashion industry)

**Gaming** (use the history of Gaming to learn game concepts then create video games)

**Health Science** (field of Allied Health-medical terminology/human body structure/clinical labs)

**Vet Assisting** (introduction to the animal industry and veterinary medicine)

Acting

**Acting** (for students serious about performing on stage)

**Technical Theater Design/Production** (support the theater program-construction/ lighting/sound)

**Theater** (for students interested in all aspects of the theater—acting/set design)

Languages

**French** (learn the basics of French Language)

**Italian** (learn the basics of the Italian language)

**Spanish 1 or 2** (learn the basics of Spanish Language)

**Band** (concert and marching band for brass, woodwinds, and percussion instruments)

**Chorus** (learn to sing or advance your vocal abilities)

Music

**Guitar** (learn to play the guitar no experience necessary)

**Jazz Ensemble** (Class for advanced musicians)

**Orchestra** (for all string instruments: violin, viola, cello, and double bass)

Other

**AVID** (Focus on college readiness, organization, study skills)

**Debate 1** (learn oral communications concepts and strategies for public debate)

**ROTC** (become a leader through ARMY leadership principles (2 years or course waives PE/Fine art)

PE

**Physical Education (circle 1: team sports, basketball –only if HOPE was taken in middle school)**

**Personal Fitness/Fitness Design** (PE class required for graduation)
